PARK SHELTER REQUIREMENTS—ADDENDUM A

Effective JUNE 26 (through Phase 4 of Restore Illinois Plan)

The following shelter rental guidelines will be in place during Phase 4 of the Restore Illinois Plan and are made in reference to broader guidelines established by the Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity Guidelines. Each organization must implement these minimum procedures during Phase 4 for use of park district property and are welcome to implement other guidelines more restrictive of these if their organizing bodies deem necessary.

- Events in the shelters are limited to 50 participants.
- Shelter amenities and bathrooms are cleaned prior to each rental. Cleaning and disinfection during the renter's event are the responsibility of the renter.
- Social distance of at least 6-ft. should be maintained between non-household individuals
- Participants should wear face coverings over their nose and mouth when social distancing cannot be maintained, except while seated throughout duration of event (exceptions can be made for people with medical conditions or disabilities that prevent them from safely wearing a face covering)
- Renters are responsible for familiarizing themselves with the state of Illinois' Phase 4 guidance for monitoring the health of guests at their event. Resources can be found here <https://dceocovid19resources.com/restore-illinois/restore-illinois-phase-4>
